Subject: New CTS, CQS, and OPRA System Output Communications Network Source Addresses –
UPDATE - Revised Dates

Summary

As previously announced, SIAC is in the process of relocating the CTS, CQS, and OPRA systems to a new data center. As a result of this effort, new CTS, CQS, and OPRA Source IP Addresses have been added to the SFTI network. In order to avoid the Russell Indexes reconstitution, July 4th holiday, expirations and to provide additional test time, **the dates that the CTS, CQS and OPRA systems are scheduled to commence disseminating multicast data with the new Source IP Addresses have been revised, as follows:**

New Source IP Implementation	July 19, 2010	July 26, 2010	August 2, 2010

As a reminder, Data Recipients who currently employ mechanisms for controlling CTS, CQS, and OPRA data flow, such as firewall and/or router filter configurations, may need to make modifications to permit the new Source IP Addresses. If necessary changes are not made, Data Recipients may not receive CTS, CQS, or OPRA multicast data. All Data Recipients will be required to process data with **both the new and existing** Source IP Addresses.

Test data for the new Source IP Addresses has been available since mid-March, 2010. Please note that test data with the new Source IP Addresses **will not be published during production hours; they will only be available afterhours.**

Testing Scheduling

Data Recipients are strongly encouraged to complete their CTS, CQS, and OPRA Data Recipient testing with the new Source IP Addresses as soon as possible. Testing continues to be available Monday through Friday evenings. To coordinate testing (written or verbal confirmation of testing is required), please register in the following way:

Test data will **not** be disseminated if Data Recipients are **not** registered to test.

Indirect Data Recipients must contact their service provider to coordinate testing.
