The purpose of this notice is to update OPRA Data Recipients on the latest available OPRA Symbology test data leading up to the implementation of Symbology on February 12th.

Symbology Data Replay

1) OSI Industry Test Data Capture: this file contains actual test data from a Saturday Symbology industry test, generated by the options exchanges (both real and test symbols). The Strike Price Code in Open Interest, Trade, and Quote messages, was replaced with a 'space' (e.g., 'A' modified to 'space').

Until Wednesday evening February 10th, replay test data will be disseminated, from 9:45pm to 10:00pm (15 minutes), utilizing Playback Test IP multicast groups (e.g., Line Name 233.43.202.97, Port 14151 for Line 1; reference the Common IP Multicast Distribution Network Interface Specification, http://www.opradata.com/specs/common_ip_multicast_distribution.pdf

On Thursday evening February 11th, replay test data will be disseminated, from 10:00pm to 11:30pm (90 minutes), utilizing Production IP multicast groups (e.g., Line Name 233.43.202.1, Port 11101 for Line 1; reference the Common IP Multicast Distribution Network Interface Specification, http://www.opradata.com/specs/common_ip_multicast_distribution.pdf
