Subject: Automated Retransmissions

Modification

The purpose of this notice is to advise all OPRA Data Recipients that SIAC will be migrating from the current dial-up method of requesting retransmissions, to an automated facility for retransmissions, beginning in September, 2009.

Enhanced Autolink

The enhanced Autolink facility will allow OPRA Data Recipients to connect directly through SFTI via predefined TCP/IP addresses. Two TCP/IP server ports will be available simultaneously on separate servers for recipients to connect.

Data Recipients will continue to provide logon identifiers and passwords, along with system, line, and sequence number information. Retransmissions will continue to be disseminated over dedicated multicast feeds.

Implementation Timeframe

Implementation is scheduled for September. A six-month transition period to allow Data Recipients to migrate to the new facility will begin in September and will be complete in March, 2010.

Further Information

The enhanced Autolink user guide and associated addresses and ports will be provided in June.
